- This is a **COLD RANGE**; No weapon will be **LOADED** unless directed by a Safety Officer to do so.
- Each Shooter will be **REQUIRED** to have a holster for their weapon.
- All Weapons **MUST** be **HOLSTERED AT ALL TIMES** unless directed by Safety Officer to draw your weapon.
- Your Weapon may only be handled at the **DIRECT COMMAND** of a Safety Officer.
- No compensated weapons will be allowed.
- All commands from a Safety Officer will be followed immediately.
- We will follow a 180 rule (your weapon may never be pointed more than the 90 degrees off the center of your body).
- **NO ALCOHOL**
- Each Shooter will need 3 magazines or 3 speed loaders for their weapon

The Range is located north of the town of Arcadia, east of Edmond. From I-35, take Exit 141, which is the old route 66 eastbound. Arcadia is approximately 8 miles. To Hiwassee Road and turn left. Proceed northbound for approximately 3 miles until you arrive at Sorghum Mill Road [also marked as NE 234th Street]. Then: continue beyond the Sorghum Mill/234th Street turnoff and continue northbound. 6/10th of a mile on the left.

MATCH RULES

- This is a **Cold Range**; No weapon will be **LOADED** unless directed by a Safety officer to do so.
- Each Shooter will be **Required** to have a holster for their weapon.
- All Weapons **MUST** be **HOLSTERED at ALL TIMES** unless directed by Safety Officer (SO) to Draw your weapon.
- **Your Weapon may only be handled at the Direct command of a Safety Officer**
- No compensated weapons will be allowed, Must be a center fire cartridge
- All commands from a Safety Officer will be followed immediately
- We will follow a 120 rule (your weapon may never be pointed more the 60 degrees off the center of your body)
- Hearing and eye protection required
- **Range Commands**
 - Shooter do you understand the course of Fire
 - Load and make ready
 - Shooter are you ready
 - Stand By
 - Then the start signal
 - **STOP** Shooter will stop and wait for instructions from the SO.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE ABOVE RULES CAN & WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION

Safety Officer Check List

1. Shooter understands above rules
2. Shooter has at least 3mags or 3 speed loaders
3. Shooter has correct ammo
4. Shooter has a holster (worn correctly)
5. Shooter has a mag carrier worn correctly (optional)
6. Weapon is empty and holstered
7. Shooter understands not to draw his or her weapon again without an SO's approval

Stock Service Pistol (SSP)

Any semi automatic pistol that fires a center fire cartridge

1. Magazines may not be loaded with more then 10 rounds

Custom Defense Pistol (CDP)

Any semi automatic pistol that fires a .45 Caliber or larger cartridge

1. Magazines may not be loaded with more then 8 rounds

Stock Service Revolver (SSR)

- 1.Any revolver that fires a center fire cartridge
